What you'll be doing:

- Championing, overseeing, and directing the congregational care needs of Covenant Church (Winterville)
- Anticipating the felt needs of the church & community and offering ministry initiatives to help
- Providing counseling to individuals, couples, or families in crisis
- Intentionally and proactively seeking life coaching opportunities
- Helping people discover their gifts and empowering them to serve
- Identifying, equipping, and deploying individuals as part of a hospital visitation team
- Championing, overseeing, and directing ministry to women in the church and community
- Planning and executing large-scale ministry events for women, including *Pursue the Passion* conference
- Providing support, guidance, and direction to the Women's Advisory Council
- Identifying, equipping, and coaching small group leaders
- Launching support groups, such as Grief Share and Divorce Care
- Launching women's small groups each semester
- Administrating the Compassion Fund, an internal benevolence fund for those in need of financial assistance
- Provoking the Compassion Fund leadership team to seek ministry opportunities beyond financial assistance

Skills you'll need to have:

- Compassionate heart for people, especially women, and a desire to help them find wholeness in Jesus
- Ability to cast vision to, inspire, and coach volunteers and small group leaders
- Organizational skills to deploy staff, teams, and individuals to assist with care needs
- Strong administrative skills to record interactions, calls, and visits
- Ability to actively listen and offer wise biblically-based counsel
- Ability to develop systems to efficiently advance ministry and communication
- Commitment to work collaboratively with staff, team, and individuals to accomplish ministry goals
